Qualtrics Survey Tool Now Available Free

Qualtrics, a premium service for creating and delivering online surveys, is now free for faculty, staff, and both undergraduate and graduate student use. UF Information Technology (UFIT) purchased a campus-wide license to make Qualtrics, free for the UF community. A typical annual license for a UF department costs \$2,500, with some larger university units paying \$5,000 a year. Under the UFIT-negotiated license the university will see an immediate savings. Postdocs should take advantage of access to this great tool.

<u>Log in</u> to Qualtrics by visiting the e-Learning Web site and selecting Qualtrics under the Research Tools category. UFIT-developed Qualtrics training will be available soon. In the meantime, <u>"Qualtrics University"</u> has some excellent online training videos to help you get started. Departments with current Qualtrics licenses may contact <u>Doug Johnson</u> or <u>James Hardemon</u> for assistance with migrating their licenses into UF's campus-wide license.
