American Cancer Society - funding opportunities due 10/15/13

Postdoctoral Fellowships

This award is to support the training of researchers who have received a doctoral degree to provide initial funding leading to an independent career in cancer research (including basic, preclinical, clinical, cancer control, psychosocial, behavioral, epidemiology, health services and health policy research). Awards may be for three years with progressive stipends of \$48,000, \$50,000, and \$52,000 per year, plus a \$4,000 per year fellowship allowance (an additional \$1,500 is added to the fellowship allowance in the last year to attend the ACS Postdoctoral Fellows Symposium or a domestic scientific meeting). Depending on availability of special endowment funds, the Society annually selects one or more of the top-ranked fellowships to be supplemented above the standard stipend. *Application Deadline: October 15, 2013*

Research Scholar Grants

Research Scholar Grants support investigator-initiated projects across the cancer research continuum. Awards are for up to four years and for up to \$165,000 per year (direct costs), plus 20% allowable indirect costs. Independent investigators in the first six years of an independent research career or faculty appointment are eligible to apply. Exceptions: 1) RSG applicants to the Cancer Control and Prevention Research Program ONLY may be at any career stage provided the focus

of their project is either: a) health policy/health services research or b) cancer disparity reduction; 2) Psychosocial or behavioral studies that are population based (5 years of funding are permitted) where a budget of \$400,000 per year (direct costs), plus 20% allowable indirect costs is permitted. *Application Deadline: October 15, 2013*
