# U.S.-Israel Binational Science Foundation (BSF) Prof. Rahamimoff Travel Grants Program for Young Scientists

The United States-Israel Binational Science Foundation (BSF) promotes scientific relations between the U.S. and Israel by supporting collaborative research projects in a wide area of basic and applied scientific fields, for peaceful and non-profit purposes.

The Prof. Rahamimoff Travel Grants Program for Young Scientists supports this goal by providing monetary travel assistance (a \$4,000 travel grant) to PhD students and post-doctoral fellows in the U.S. to visit a research facility or institution of higher education in Israel that will provide them with access to facilities or expertise not available to them in the United States. The program also supports young Israeli researchers making a trip to the United States.

The University of Florida may submit a maximum of FIVE (5) applications to the program.

Interested applicants should review the program website carefully and provide a CV and an internal Letter of Intent (LOI; <u>click here for guidelines</u>) indicating the proposed dates of travel, consent of the applicant's University of Florida research supervisor, and the name, field, and institution of the proposed host scientist in Israel, no later than February 26, 2014, to the UF Office of Research (Attn: Jeevan Jyot, <u>limitedprograms@research.ufl.edu</u>).

Applications are due to BSF by April 10, 2014,
