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Important Information re: Postdoc Insurance:

Effective July 1, 2013, the University of Florida's insurance plan for Postdoctoral Associates and Postdoctoral Fellows will be provided as part of GatorCare, the University's new self-insured health plan. The name of the plan is GatorCare Options. For further details about GatorCare in general, please visit <u>http://gatorcare.org</u>.

Newly hired Postdoctoral Associates and Postdoctoral Fellows will be able to complete their GatorCare Options enrollment via the myUFL system. Detailed instructions on how to enroll can be found on the attachment.

Important deadlines:

- New hires must complete enrollment within 60 days of hire.
- Qualifying event changes must be completed within 60 days of the event.
- Open enrollment elections must be completed prior to the end of open enrollment.

Trouble Signing In to Abstract Form Submission Site:

If you are prompted to sign in to the Form site, use your Gatorlink credentials to sign in. This is a UF restricted SharePoint site. It is recommended that you use Internet Explorer as your browser. If signing in from a UF (office) computer, should get signed in automatically. If you are signing in from elsewhere and receive a prompt, sign in using the following:

When prompted to sign in, use your **Gatorlink username** (example for <u>Albert@ufl.edu</u>, your Gatorlink username is "Albert". If you have an email address like "<u>AlbertGator@medicine.ufl.edu</u>", that is not your Gatorlink. You can also enter in your entire Gatorlink email address (example: "<u>Albert@ufl.edu</u>") as your username. Enter in your Gatorlink password in the password field.

Smathers Libraries' Government Documents collection to relocate

The George A. Smathers Libraries Government Documents collection is being permanently relocated to the libraries' off-campus Auxiliary Library Facility (ALF). The move will be completed by March 21 and documents can be requested from the collection beginning March 31. During the time the collection is inaccessible, the Regional Documents Coordinator and other campus library information desk staff will assist patrons with electronic access to government documents, or in conjunction with Interlibrary Loan staff, borrow materials from the University of Central Florida or the University of Georgia. After March 31 materials housed at ALF may be requested using the request link in the catalog.

Although the collection will no longer be on campus, the University of Florida will remain the Regional Depository Library for Florida, Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands.

The move of materials and staff offices of Government Documents and Map & Imagery collections is opening up space for the first floor renovation of the Marston Science Library. The 26,000 square-foot area will include seating and study space for 680 students. The renovation will be completed by the beginning of the fall 2014 semester.
