

Help increase your competitive edge at a full-day workshop at the Innovation Hub run by Jim Greenwood of Greenwood Consulting, nationally known for helping companies, entrepreneurs and inventors like you achieve success in these programs. The SBIR/STTR Proposal Preparation Workshop begins with a strong overview of the programs, including an update of important changes from their recent reauthorization by Congress. It then goes through a simple but comprehensive four-step process for developing a credible and competitive Phase 1 (up to \$150,000) proposal. # God and the End of Satan: An Artist's Journey to Translating and Publishing Victor Hugo's Poetry

Tuesday, March 15, 2016, 3:00-4:00 p.m. Library West, Room 212 (Scott Nygren Scholars Studio)



In 2014, artist and writer Richard Skinner published *God and the End of Satan / Dieu et la Fin de Satan*, a bilingual edition of selected verses from Victor Hugo's two epic poems, most of which had never been translated into English. Skinner will talk about the journey that led him to the publication of this translation, from the reason why he decided to undertake this project, to his meticulous search of Hugo's manuscript.

Trained in art at Antioch College, Skinner spent years as a professional artist, while maintaining an active interest in writing and 19<sup>th</sup> century French poetry. Returning from a

year of painting in France, Skinner began translating his favorite poets, and upon arrival in Gainesville in 1997, began the slow process of tackling Victor Hugo's visionary works. In 2015, his translation was reviewed very positively by journals such as *Nineteenth Century French Studies*.
