2016 National Postdoc Survey Extended through July 30th

We have heard your requests — the 2016 National Postdoc Survey has been extended through the month of July!

Our survey will remain active until July 30th, and can be accessed using the original survey link and information found below.

While thousands have already responded, we would like to offer additional postdocs one last chance to participate. Please help us to ensure that all postdocs have had an opportunity to make their voices heard by sharing this information with them.

Please find below a link to the 2016 National Postdoctoral Survey (NPS) to forward to all postdocs currently in your institution (IRB protocol # IRB15-1724, University of Chicago). This survey was conceived and developed by postdocs in order to identify important issues within the national postdoctoral community. The results of this survey will provide critical data to help inform and equip those who advocate for policy on behalf of postdocs everywhere.

We invite all postdoctoral scholars, fellows, and non-faculty post-PhD researchers to participate (independent of academic field or discipline). All answers are completely anonymous and we estimate that the survey will take 15-20 minutes to complete on average. Upon completion, participants may choose to enter their contact information for a chance to win travel awards to a scientific meeting of their choice. You can help bring a voice to the postdoctoral community by completing the survey!

Institutions with at least 50 postdoc respondents to the survey will be eligible to receive summary results from their specific institutions upon request, which will be useful for comparison to national benchmarks. Regardless, all postdoc data will contribute, and institutions with fewer respondents may instead receive summary results compiled from peer institutions.
