F32 fellowships are competitive and prestigious grants awarded by the National Institutes of Health to individual postdoctoral researchers to support scientific training and career development. The award pays the full NIH-recommended stipend for postdocs based on years of postdoctoral experience as well as additional funds for health care expenses and professional development, including conference and travel costs. Importantly, receipt of this award can help postdoctoral trainees to build a track record of funding and support from the NIH that is essential for success in a career as an independent scientist.
